



RANKING POINTS RULES

- OPBU rankings are completely independent rankings dedicated only for professional fighters and professional title fights under full muaythai and modified muaythai (Thai boxing or K-1) rules.
- **Oriental pro boxing** is common name for disciplines coming from orient (Thailand & Japan) with basic similarities regarding certain techniques (no foot protections, low kicks, thai shorts, same boxing & kicking techniques, boxing ring, fights of 5x3').
- Fighters on OPBU rankings are rated according to their results all over the world, no matter on which show or under which organisation or title they were fighting for.
- To be rated by OPBU, it is important fighter's activities and with whome he fought, his performance and final result. Sometimes could be enough only his performance if he fought top level fighter, no matter on final result of that fight or tournament. That's why, from January the 1st 2008 we will start using points award system in order to get the best and most credible rankings.
- K-1 and K-1 MAX champions and super stars, WBC MT world and KOTR super champions will not be ranked but they will be nominated as extra possible contenders and they will gain the points as well.
- Every position on OPBU rankings will carry certain number of points. Adding to this points other award points for activity and results, fighter will have a chance to advance on the rankings. If he has no activities or bad results, he will go down on the rankings.
- Only fighters rated in the top 20 on the OPBU official rankings will get points. Those who enter the top 20 rating during the year will begin earning points from that period on and from the position they will be puted on (together with the points for that position). If the fighter drop from top 20 he will have to start from zero.
- Rated fighters are only those who are fighting under full muaythai rules and modified muaythai rules (Thai boxing or K-1 or KO WS rules) and only those fights will be taken in consideration for rankings.



- OPBU ranking points for the position on official OPBU rankings:

Place no.1 = 360 pts; place no.2 = 310 pts; place no.3 = 270 pts; place no.4 = 240 pts;
 place no.5 = 210 pts; place no.6 = 180 pts; place no.7 = 160 pts; place no.8 = 140 pts;
 Place no.9 = 120 pts; place no.10 = 100 pts; place no.11 = 80 pts; place no.12 = 70 pts;
 Place no.13 = 60 pts; place no.14 = 50 pts; place no.15 = 40 pts; place no.16 = 30 pts;
 Place no.17 = 25 pts; place no.18 = 20 pts; place no.19 = 15 pts; place no.20 = 10 pts;

- Only other rankings and titles to be taken in consideration for OPBU award points are:

- WBC MUAYTHAI world rankings
- WIPU KINGS OF THE RING independent oriental pro boxing world super star rankings

- Extra bonus for recognised champions:

- OPBU regional champion = 10 pts
- OPBU champion = 30 pts
- WBC MUAYTHAI International champion = 30 pts
- WIPU KING OF THE RING super champion (single fight) = 50 pts
- WBC MUAYTHAI world champion = 50 pts
- K-1 world champion = 70 pts
- S-1, IT'S SHOWTIME, KO WORLD SERIES, WIPU KOTR, K-1 MAX, K-1 super champion (tournament fights) = 100 pts

- OPBU award points for tournament fights recognised by OPBU:

World GP tournaments (K-1, KOTR, KO WS, IT'S SHOWTIME, S-1)

- SEMI FINALS	15 pts	/	20 pts	5 pts
- FINALS	20 pts	/	40 pts	5 pts

1. SINGLE FIGHT

FIGHTER A won by KO **FIGHTER B** (who is among 10) for OPBU / WBC MT International title

FIGHTER A makes:

20 points for winning + 5 pts for KO
 10 pts for beating a top 10 + 5 for KO
 10 pts for winning OPBU title + 5 for KO
 10 pts for winning WBC MT Int. title + 5 for KO
TOTAL = 70 pts

FIGHTER B makes:

10 points for loosing
 5 pts for loosing vs top 10
 5 pts for loosing OPBU title
 5 pts for loosing WBC MT Int. Title
TOTAL = 25 pts

2. TOURNAMENT

FIGHTER A won **K-1 WORLD GP 8 MAN TOURNAMENT** against 3 fighters and all on pts

FIGHTER B won 2nd place by losing against **fighter A** who is rated among first 10 but first two fights he won by KO

FIGHTER A makes:

- 20 pts for winning in a first fight
- 7 pts for beating fighter between 10-20
- 20 pts for winning in 1 / 2 finals
- 10 pts for beating a top 10
- 40 pts for winning WORLD GP

TOTAL = 97 pts

FIGHTER B makes:

- 20 pts for winning first fight + 5 for KO
- 3 pts for beating not ranked fighter + 1 for KO
- 20 pts for winning 1 / 2 finals + 5 for KO
- 10 pts for beating a top 10 + 5 for KO
- 20 pts for winning 2nd place in WORLD GP
- 5 pts for losing against top 10 fighter

TOTAL = 94 pts
